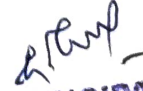
Synopsis (75-100 words)

Department of Zoology organized long study tour 2025-26 for B.Sc II ,III and II on 22.12.2025 to 24.12.2025. The Aim of study tour is to observe animals in their natural habitats. The tour was arranged to Vita, Kolhapur, Kunakeshwar, Malvan, Vengurla. The tour began with a visit to Gokul Milk Dairy, where students observed milk processing and marketing units, including quality testing, pasteurization, packaging, and distribution systems. This visit helped students understand modern dairy technology and management practices. Next, the group visited Radhanagari Wildlife Sanctuary, where the Butterfly Garden was explored and various butterfly species were observed. The tour then proceeded to Rautwadi Waterfall, followed by an overnight stay at Kunkeshwar. On the next day, students visited Kunkeshwar Temple and conducted beach exploration activities. Marine organisms such as sea urchins, sea anemones, barnacles, and crabs were observed. A beach cleanliness program was organized, in which students actively participated.

Further, the group visited Tsunami Island, Malvan, where dolphins were observed during boating and the Brahminy Kite (Red-backed Sea Eagle) was spotted at Sea Eagle Point. A giant spider was also observed during a walking trail, and photographs were taken for documentation. The tour continued with a visit to Rock Garden for sunset viewing and a light show, followed by a stay at Vengurla. Students then visited the Regional Fruit Research Station, Vengurla, and Shiroda Beach, after which the return journey was started.

To provide practical exposure to industrial and ecological systems.	Students understood the importance of biodiversity conservation.

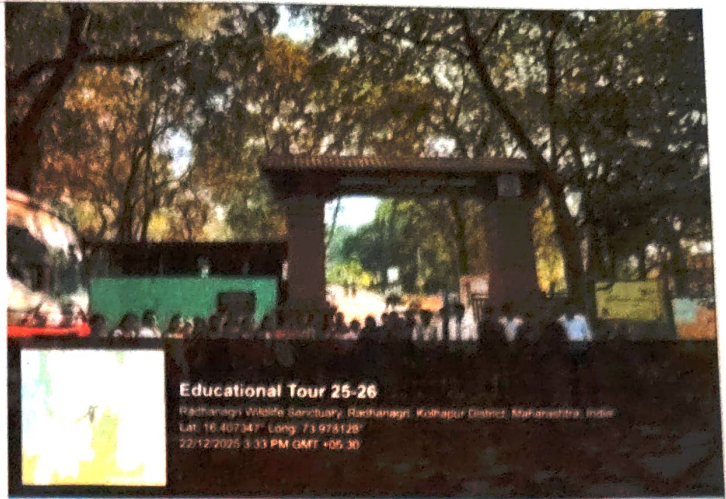
