To create awareness regarding importance of venomous and non venomous snakes.

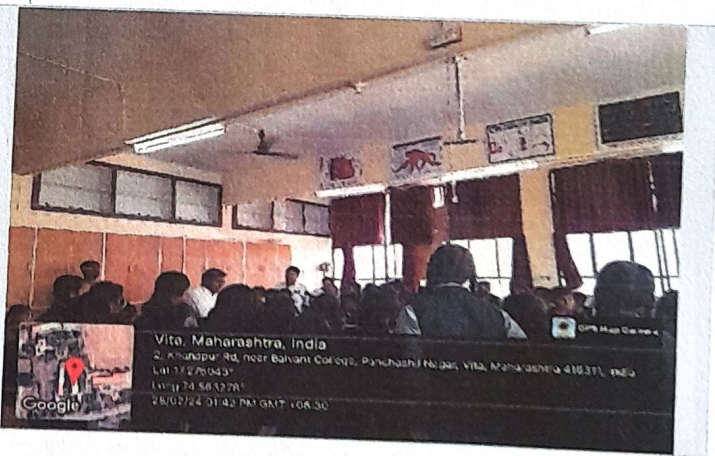
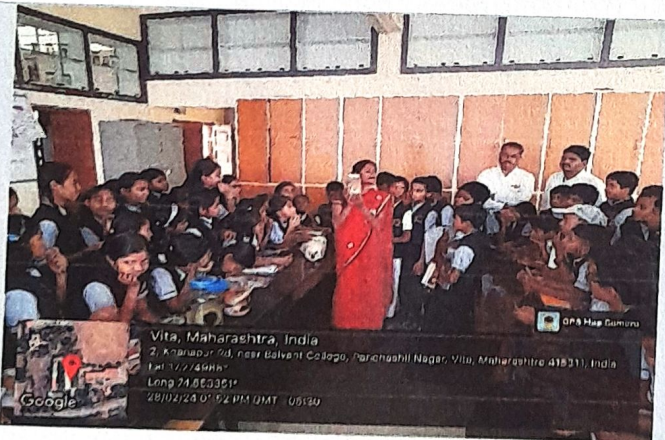
The students became aware of the importance of snakes in ecosystem.
