Under the leadership of Kanhoji Angre, it withstood many naval attacks by the British and the Dutch. as it is widely considered the birthplace of helium. In the 19th century, a British scientist named Sir Joseph Norman Lockyer discovered the element while observing a total solar eclipse.

Then we reach to the Kunkeshwar and visit to the temple of lord shiva aroung 4.00 pm.

DAY 2 (03/06/2023) visit to Sindhudurg

Sindhudurg Fort is a historical fort that occupies an islet in the Arabian Sea, just off the coast of Maharashtra in Western India. The fortress lies on the shore of
