Though the committee and participants are keen to invite professional and expert trainees and speakers of national repute, the cell is unable to host programmes due to inconvenience as the college is situated in the rural area at tehsil place. The college has been observing better results of women empowerment since the IQAC and Women Empowerment Committee has worked and designed various activities for girls. Girls are encouraged to take part in or participate in educational tours, cultural events, sports events NCC and NSS related events. Therefore, during the academic and administrative process, they have been noticeably preferred.
